

Design Center Appointment Checklist

The following are things to consider prior to and during your Design Center Consultation to help you get the most out of your meeting.

- Schedule your appointment. Expect to spend between two and three hours with your design consultant. During this time, you'll be able to review, price and select a variety of products.
- Remember to bring your checkbook. A deposit may be required when you finalize your selection.
- Ask your counselor about selection cut-off dates. To keep the construction of your new home on schedule you will need to finalize your flooring selection 60 days prior to close of escrow.
- Prior to your consultation, spend some time thinking about your lifestyle characteristics and daily routine and how these attributes might affect your design decisions. Making a list of the hobbies and interests of everyone in your family can help with design decisions.
- Bring your ideas to your consultation. A cushion from your sofa, a fabric swatch from your new chair, a paint chip or even a picture from a magazine of a beautiful room that inspires you.
- Review your floor plan and assess each of the different rooms. Explore how each room will be used. This will help you determine the mood and style each room will reflect.
- Create a furniture plan by taking measurements of your furniture and determining where each piece will be placed.
